A. GENERAL

District 6 will conduct an open, single elimination tournament for Class 1A, 2A, 3A, 4A, 5A, and 6A teams.

The Champion and runner-up of the class 1A, 2A and 3A advance. Class 4A includes 2 District 5 teams who have elected to play through District 6 for the one spot in the State Play-offs. Class 5A and 6A champion will play a regional game for the right to advance to the State Play-offs.

District 5 teams Bedford and Somerset will compete in the 4A Field.

District 8, 9, and 10 will compete with the District 6 champion for the one State play-off berth in Class 5A

In Class 6A, the District 6 winner will play District 10 for the State play-off berth.

B. ENTRY

Each school desiring to enter the playoffs is responsible to:

1. Calculate their Power Rating after their game on Wednesday, May 10, 2017 for 1A, 2A and 3A schools. Calculate their Power rating after their game on Wednesday, May 17 for 4A, 5A and 6A schools.
2. **Email (preferred method) or fax the Baseball Entry/Power Rating form by:**
Thursday by 10 am on May 11 for 1A, 2A and 3A.
Thursday by 10 am on May 18 for 4A, 5A and 6A.
3. **Schools submitting their Entry Form and Power Rating after that date and time will not be entered in the playoffs.**

C. ENTRY FEE

A school, which has entered the playoffs, shall mail the \$100 entry fee payable to PIAA District VI to the Baseball Chairman on/or before Thursday, May 11, 2017 along with the Entry Fee Form.

D. SEEDING

- 1. Power rating – Four (4) points are received for each victory.
- 2. Bonus points are awarded for defeating
 - “1A” team - one point, “4A” team – four points
 - “2A” team - two points, “5A” team – five points
 - “3A” team - three points “6A” team – six points

Two additional points are awarded for a victory over a team with a winning percentage of .700 or higher.

It is the responsibility of the team claiming classification points from teams outside of Pennsylvania to provide the Baseball Chairman or Tournament Director either:

- a. Male 2016-17 enrollment number on school letterhead signed by opposing AD or Principal.
- b. Email confirmation of male 2016-17 enrollment from opposing AD or Principal.

It is the responsibility of the team claiming bonus points from teams outside of District 6 to provide the Baseball Chairman or Tournament Director either:

- a. school record on school letterhead signed by opposing AD.
- b. email confirmation of team record from opposing AD.

Total points earned would be divided by the number of games played at the deadline date to determine the rating to be used for seeding. Schools with identical Power Ratings will be seeded by head to head games, then by game percentage won, then by a coin flip.

E. PLAYING FIELD

Games, except the finals, which are scheduled for People’s Natural Gas Field (Blair County Ball Park), will be played on the baseball field of the opponent that has the higher Power Rating.

F. HOME TEAM

The team with the higher Power Rating shall be the **home** team and **host** the game.

G. BRACKETS AND PLAYING DATES

Brackets will be e- mailed to each school entering the playoffs on or before May 12th. Playing dates are:

Note: Infield practice times are listed above...NO SPIKES may be worn in the infield during this time. Batting practice will be in indoor cages. District 6 reserves the right to change game times, dates and location due to weather, field availability and school end-of-year schedule issues.

I. POSTPONED GAME

A game, which is postponed, shall be played the next day – except on a Sunday. The only exception will be if a school has Graduation or another event approved by the Baseball Chairman.

J. RESPONSIBILITIES

1. The school with the higher Power Rating will provide a game manager, the playing field (except for final game), at least six (6) new baseballs, ball chasers, and the official scorekeeper.
NOTE: The District VI Committee will provide the baseballs for the championship games.
2. District VI will hire and pay the umpires. Three umpires will be assigned for all play-off games except the Championship game, which will have four umpires.
3. District VI will award a trophy and 25 individual plaque awards to the champion of each classification.
4. District VI will secure and pay rental fees for Peoples' Natural Gas Field.
5. The home team Athletic Director, Game manager or Head Coach will report the game score to the Tournament Director **the day of the game. Call or text 814-241-2626.**
6. Schools will keep their local media informed.
7. Except for the final game, the host school will make the following phone calls when a game has to be postponed.
(A) Opponents; (B) Umpire contact Person; (C) Chairman; (D) News Media

K. ADMISSION PRICES

No admission is charged for games except for the final game. Student tickets are \$3 and adult tickets are \$6.
