These changes were made to ensure correct and timely calculations. Please also be sure to include THE RECORDS OF TEAMS WRESTLED so proper seeding can be determined in a timely manner. Rich CAN NOT search/ call all teams outside District 6 that you may have wrestled and still complete the seeding points in the time we have for turnaround.

If you wrestle out-of-state teams, you will also need to provide the following information:

1. School enrollment (for classification) (for team)
2. Wrestler name (for individual seeding)
3. Wrestler Weight (for individual seeding)
4. Wrestler's Place Finish in Districts or Regionals or States (for individual seeding)

All teams will receive an entry pass for each wrestler entered, 4 coaches, a manager, and a school hired trainer. Additional passes for current team members and 2 additional coaches can be purchased for \$1 each at the seeding meeting.

Reminder... Regional Meet is February 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> at TBA. Top 6 wrestlers in each weight class advance.

**Team Duals-** All tickets for team prelims and finals will be \$10. These will be sold online only through hometown ticketing. Fans of District 6 member schools can purchase tickets by going to the PIAA District 6 website at [www.piaad6.org](http://www.piaad6.org) and click on the Play-off ticket link located in the center of the home page. No tickets will be sold at Team Wrestling Districts.

Contest management - District 6 will pay the game manger \$160, Officials (per match \$70 prelims, \$80 finals).

Each Host site will receive a stipend to pay their event staff. This should include at least, trainer, table workers, security, ticket scanner, and announcer. As the host site, you are not paying for transportation. You can open your concession stand and have a 50/50 if you desire.
