This schedule is weather dependent and subject to change.

Opening Heights AA Meet Using Both Pole Vault Pits

Girls: 7'0'' \rightarrow Using the pole vault pit by the track

Boys: 10'0" \rightarrow Using the pole vault pit by the goal post

This is six (6) inches below the district qualifying heights. (7'6" and 10'6")

Note:

The top three (3) placers automatically qualify out of District VI for the state championship with up to six (6) competitors who meet the state qualifying standards.

Opening Heights AAA Meet Using One Pole Vault Pit

The girls will compete first, followed by the boys 50 minutes <u>after</u> the completion of the girls' event.

Even though each team is allowed to enter three competitors in each event, we use the standards of the AA meet and adjust for the state qualifying heights:

Girls: 7'0" Boys: 9' 9"

Note:

The winner automatically qualifies out of District VI for the state championship with up to six (6) competitors who meet the state qualifying standards.

Pole Vault Weigh-Ins: 2:15 – 3:15 (Located in the Visitor's locker room)

Runway Closes/Rules: 3:25 Competition Begins: 3:30

Pole Vault Weight Verification Forms

Each team will bring an UNSIGNED weight verification form to weigh-ins.

Separate forms for each sex is required.

Only items before weigh-ins on the form:

- 1. School's Name
- 2. Competing Pole Vaulters Names
- 3. Competing Pole Vaulters Grades

After all of your pole vaulters are weighed in, the head coach will then list EACH pole EACH vaulter is planning to use based on the individual pole vaulter's weight. The head coach will then sign the form and present this to the pole inspector out by the pole vault pits.
