## <u>District 6 AA Wrestling Tournament February 18-19, 2022-</u> <u>Altoona Area High School Field House</u>

Entry Fee \$50 per team plus \$10 per wrestler. (ex. Team brings one wrestler fee is \$60, Team brings 13 wrestlers fee is \$180).

- **Saturday February 12** Last day individual wrestler points can be used/calculated. Coaches are responsible for calculating wrestler points.
- Monday February 14 6:00pm Deadline for coaches to enter wrestlers in flo. Coaches can now start entering wrestlers participating in the tournament in flo. Here is the direct link to the tournament. Team passwords have been sent out to coaches to access the tournament portal. If you have not received a team password, please let me know.
- Monday February 14 Before 10:00pm I will send out an excel sheet to this email list of wrestlers participating in the tournament including seeding and points earned per wrestler.
- **Tuesday February 15 6:00pm** Seeding meeting via zoom. A zoom link will be emailed to you prior to the seeding meeting.
- Tuesday February 15 before 10:00pm Brackets will be posted on flo.
- All teams will receive an entry pass for each wrestler entered, 4 coaches, a manager, and a school hired trainer. Additional passes for current team members and 2 additional coaches can be purchased for \$5 each at the seeding meeting.

Spectators can enter at either the Field House Lobby or ticket hall way off of 14<sup>th</sup> street.

<u>Tickets will be cash only at the door. \$10 a session, \$18 a day.</u> There will be no online tickets.

There is NO mask requirements.

Parking - Team vans will park in the lower teacher lot behind the Field House (where they have before). There will be someone there to direct them. This lot will be reserved for team vans, workers, media, and officials only. Buses will drop off in front of the Field House and be directed to park at the Railroaders Museum on 8<sup>th</sup> Ave.

On Friday during the day, fan parking will be sparse. We have an in service that day. We do have a new lot in front of New High School Building, behind Field House, and the 7<sup>th</sup> Ave parking lot. These will be completely open for Friday's second session and all day Saturday.

Championship Apparel will be sold during the event. Please let your team know.

Coaches will need to bring eligibility sheet with them to the meet and give them to Paul Myers when they check in their team.
